Anonymous Giving

You can give to Trinity Hills Baptist Church with the confidence that your gift is appreciated and treated with confidence. We respect your privacy and trust.

If you want credit for your gift, then you must tell us your name and address. This allows us to prepare an end-of-the-year acknowledgment letter that IRS requires for income tax purposes.

If you are not interested in income tax deductions and wish to remain anonymous, then we will honor your intentions. If you wish to remain anonymous, you should be aware of several things.

First, if your gift is designated we must know how you want to designate it. There is a church form for this. (Please look at DESIGNATING GIFTS.) Ask in the office. It informs people who handle church expenses of your intentions. If you rely on making your intentions known to someone verbally, you may be disappointed. Don't rely on spoken words, please use the church form.

Second, if you decide to use your personal money to buy something for a church ministry, please tell us. Whether you want credit or not, it is important for the office to know the real cost of a ministry. When we prepare the next year's budget we need to know the real cost.
