Designating Giving

A designated gift is where the giver says how they want the gift used. For special needs you can designate a gift. Trinity Hills Baptist Church will try to follow your wishes. It is most important for you to inform the church office of your designation. When designating a gift use both the offering envelop and your check to show your designation.

When starting a new designation, there is a form to state the purpose of your gift so it is known by those involved in church finances. Please do not depend on verbal instructions. Use the form when necessary. Most designated gifts require no clarification. Gifts to Lottie Moon Christian Offering are well understood. Setting up a fund for a special purpose does require explanation; such as a scholarship for a marriage enrichment retreat.

In the event the church has a question or problem with a designated gift it is important that the donor be contacted. If a gift is given anonymously we have no way of getting any further information.

Often church members use their personal money to help in church work. This is appreciated, but it is important that you let the church office know about your gift. Without this information we cannot accurately estimate the cost of church ministries in subsequent church budgets.

It is important also for any non-cash gift that you receive a receipt or acknowledgement letter stating your name and address and describing your gift. IRS requires this. (SEE END-OF-YEAR GIVING)
